This carnival aims at providing young competitors another chance to hit out prior to heading south for the States and Aussies.

1. CLUB ENTRIES

- 1.1 Selected Individual events will be conducted in the U11, U12, U13, U14, U15 and U17 age categories, with a list of events contained in Item 3 (Competition Events) later in the bulletin.

The WBC Branch U11-U17 Carnival will be conducted under the rules as published in the relevant sections of the current edition - of SLSA's Surf Sports Manual and any subsequent amendment bulletin available.

- 1.2 **Entries are invited from all clubs** for the events as listed under Item 3. Please enter your nominations through **Qld Carnival Manager** Program. Nomination fee will be \$5.00 per person per event.
- 1.3 No faxed entries will be permitted. Branch will invoice clubs for nomination fees after the championships.

ENTRIES CLOSE ON SUNDAY, 24 JANUARY 2021

1.4 All members wishing to compete at the competition must:-

1.4.1 Have completed a Proficiency Test by 31 December, 2020. New members of the association gaining their SRC Certificate and Bronze Medallion during the 2020 season, up until closing of nominations (24/01/2021), will be considered as satisfying the proficiency requirements for entry to the competition.

1.4.2 Have properly completed, and signed the Association Application for Membership Form.

1.4.3 Junior members U11 to U14 must have completed their Age Awards and Competition Evaluations prior to entering the competition.

NOTE: It is an offence to enter a person who does not meet the requirements under Item 1.4, and any irregularities will be considered by the Branch. Random checks of all entries will be carried out upon receipt - any club entry found to be incorrectly completed and/or missing proficiency or exemption records will be dealt with accordingly.

1.5 Events will be conducted in accordance with the Surf Sports Manual, 36th Edition plus any subsequent amendment bulletins from SLSA Australia.

1.6 Director of Surf Sports or Delegate will be liaising with individual clubs about IRB, and also IRB Drivers and Crews requirement.

5.0 Competitor conditions

5.1 Personal Protective Equipment – PPE

All Junior Activities Member 14 years and under shall wear PPE at all times during open water activities.

Whilst PPE is optional for all other members, it is highly recommended that they have access to PPE should conditions change during the course of the Championships.

5.2 High Vis Vest

In Keeping with SLSQ High Visibility Clothing Policy, High Vis Pink Vests must be worn during ALL water events.

- 6.0 SLSWBC is operating under an Industry Approved COVID- Safe Plan and as such there will be slight alterations to the manner in which the events is delivered, with a number of Covid-Safe processes and guidelines being implemented this year.
