\$16.50 per person (inc GST) for unlimited events.

Late Entry Fee:

\$33 per person plus entry fee (\$16.50) = \$49.50 (inc GST)

Entry Requirements

All competitors must be proficient in their appropriate SLSA award prior to the close of nominations.

NB: It is an offence to enter a person who does not meet any of the above requirements, and any irregularities will be considered and may be subjected to disciplinary action.

Clubs outside Wide Bay Capricorn Branch in Queensland are welcome to enter the competitions (as per Council – Executive meeting of 24.10.09) if they assist with providing judges and officials at the championships.

MEDALS/TROPHIES

Following Surf Sports and Council meetings on 20 July 2019 and endorsement, only winners and place getters from U11 to U17 age group events will receive Branch Championships medals at the event.

Club point scores will be determined on a 6 point for 1st place down to 1 point for 6th place across all events. An overall club point score (Gillian Harvey Board Riding Championship shield) and handicap club point score (William Cumming Board Riding Handicap shield) will be awarded to the clubs at Annual Dinner and Presentation.

COMPETITION CONDITIONS

Competition conditions for all events will be in accordance with the current Edition SLSA Surf Sports Manual. In Keeping with SLSQ High Visibility Clothing Policy, High Vis Pink Vests must be worn during ALL water events.

Personal Protective Equipment – PPE

Whilst PPE is optional for all other members, it is highly recommended that they have access to PPE should conditions change during the course of the Championships.

Each club must have a Team Manager complete the online Team Manager Declaration before their club is eligible to compete at Branch Board Riding Championships. Please ensure they complete online before 14 November 2021.

COVID SAFE

SLS Wide Bay Capricorn will have Check-In QLD QR Codes placed throughout the competition area and back of beach where all attendees will be required to check-in. All must complete this upon arrival at the Event.

Hand Sanitiser

Hand Sanitiser will be available at all access points to the carnival area & club tent area. Competitors, officials, staff and support personnel will be expected to use this hand Sanitiser.

Recommendations

SLS Wide Bay Capricorn recommend that anyone attending an event have the COVID-Safe app

SLS Wide Bay Capricorn are taking the above guidelines extremely seriously and all members/clubs will be required to follow instructions for the event.

SLS Wide Bay Capricorn needs to set an example on how to run these events successfully and safely and we need the compliance of clubs to make this possible.

PROTEST

Protest should be lodged with Appeals Committee. The fee, \$110 is only accepted as CASH. Should the appeal be successful, the fee will be refunded.

MISCONDUCT

Misconduct before, during and after the carnivals will not be tolerated. Offending members risk disciplinary action against themselves and their clubs.

A Carnival Disciplinary Committee has been appointed with powers to take whatever action is necessary as a result of misconduct and will be readily available to convene as required.
